Banking over the Christmas and New Year period

With the summer holidays almost upon us, it is a good time to highlight banking timeframes over the Christmas and New Year period. As you will be aware, the banking due dates over this period are affected by the public holidays between 24 December and 5 January. The banking due dates are:

- week ending 18 December 2022 due Friday 23 December 2022
- week ending 25 December due Tuesday 10 January 2023
- week ending 1 January 2023 due Tuesday 10 January 2023
- week ending 8 January 2023 due Friday 13 January 2023

However, we urge venues to bank regularly through the period to reduce the risk of theft and most

importantly to reduce the risk of harm to staff from having large amounts of cash on your premises.
